Vision for high quality, rounded provision at Watling Park School

Back in early 2015, Bellevue Place Education Trust (BPET) became the approved promoter of a new Free School in Barnet, that has since become Watling Park School.

Starting a new school is never easy and in this instance not helped by two years on a temporary site. However the recent results of the school are very positive with 71% of our Reception aged children (now in Year 1) achieving a Good Level of Development, which is the same as children nationally and 75% of children in Year 1 passing their phonics check, which is just below what children do nationally. But we are striving for more. To this end the Trust will be holding a session for all parents at 5pm on Monday 4 December. The purpose of the session is to briefly reflect on the challenging start that we've had but most importantly to acknowledge the success of our children and to outline the vision for how we will ensure that every child in our school succeeds emotionally, physically and academically.


