As it is book week at school, we would like to announce that we have now purchased 'Bug Club' access for all of our pupils. It is an online reading platform which provides an additional opportunity for your child to read age-appropriate books at home. Also, it is fun and engaging!

Your child will have log in details stuck in their reading records to allow them to log in and read books. All the books are levelled, just like our home reading books, to ensure that they are appropriate for your child's current reading skills. The class teacher will allocate them a set of books which will appear when the child logs in. Children can also answer questions about the books whilst they are reading. Class teachers can see which books have been read and also see the answers to the questions.
