Reading: Please continue to read with your child every day. Please record this in the reading record 2-3 times every week. **If you were [choose one of the characters from your book], what would you be feeling/thinking/wondering/wishing? Why?**

Spelling: Please practise Year 2 spellings from the back of your homework book. You can choose a new way to practise them from the ideas sheet.

English: This week within topic we looked at some of the buildings that were found within London at the time of the 'Great Fire'. Draw a picture of your own home, and label the different parts. Verbally explain how your home is similar/different to those built 400 hundred years ago.



Support: Here are some key words to help you: house, flat, window, wall, door, roof, floor, path, garden, brick, wood, straw, black, white, red.

Challenge: Write an explanation of the similarities and differences. Remember to mention colour, shape, size and materials.

Maths: We have begun learning about money. Look at real coins and notes and discuss their value. Order the coins from smallest value to largest.



Support: Help your child by talking about the value of money and how it used within real life (i.e. shopping, paying bills).

Challenge: Make 10p using different coins. How many different combinations can you find? How many ways can you make 20p? What do you notice?
