
Year 1 Homework Due in: Wednesday 23rd May

Reading: Please continue to read with your child every day. Record this in the reading records 2-3 times every week. Please revise all phonics sounds, especially those your child may be struggling with. For example; a_e, i_e, o_e, u_e as in cake, smile, phone, huge.



Spelling: Please practise Year 1 spellings from the back of your homework book. You can choose a way to practise them from the ideas sheet.

English: Next week we will be writing speech into speech bubbles and sometimes learning how to use speech marks. Can you write a short conversation between any of the following: dragon, knight, princess?



Support: Use simple speech bubbles to record both speakers.

Challenge: Write your conversation in sentences using speech marks, e.g. "Can I have a bedtime story, mum?" "Yes of course you can," mum replied.

Maths: We have begun to learn about time. Children learn about time at best when it is used daily. Everyday make an effort to look at what time you have breakfast, lunch, dinner, bath time, story time and so on. What is your favourite time of day?

Support: Draw pictures to show what you do during the day.

Challenge: Add the time of day to each picture. For example 'seven o' clock'.

Outdoors: On a sunny day go outside in the morning and mark where you see your shadow. Check where your shadow is at different times of the day. Talk about what happened with your adult.

Next Week's Learning:

English:

Reading an alternative traditional tale (Jim and the Beanstalk) and making comparisons with the well-known version.

Maths:

Telling the time to the hour (e.g. o' clock) and half past.

Topic:

Learning about Elizabeth II. We will continue to mould and construct with clay. This week we will be making dragons.
