## Playground Supervision

- Ensure children are not running around as this is how accidents and bumps happen.

### Lunches

Our cook, Esperance, has been doing a wonderful job with preparing our lunches and it has been lovely to see so many children enjoying a hot meal at school.

As we grow bigger, we are introducing a slight change regarding lunches. You can now opt to have packed lunch on some days and school dinners on others but you must ensure we know this well in advance.

A letter and form will be going home this week to explain. It is important that you fill in the form and return it urgently so Esperance is able to order the appropriate quantities in preparation for the new system which will start on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> September.

Remember – every child from Reception to Yr 2 are given a free hot lunch every day. From Yr 3, children will need to pay for lunches unless they show documentation to say they are eligible for free school meals.

Miss Gibbons will get the menu sent out in the next couple of days for your information.

**PACKED LUNCHES:** There is quite a lot of confusion for the children regarding whether crisps are acceptable in packed lunches.
