Labelling Uniform:

Please ensure that all uniform (including PE Kits, shoes, trainers, swimming costumes and towels) are clearly labelled with your child's name and class. Items occasionally are misplaced by the children and, if clearly labelled, can be returned when found.

'Iron on' and 'sew on' name tags can be purchased online. Permanent marker pens and biro pens (which will need re-writing after a period of time) are a quick and effective way of labelling items.

Please Note:

- Long hair should be tied back using only navy and black hair bands and/or clips.
- Watches and small stud earrings are the only permitted jewellery items, but they must be removed during PE, games or swimming.
- Nail varnish and make-up must not be worn.
- The school respects cultural dress and the uniform may be modified accordingly in consultation with the headteacher.
